Interpretation

1 In this Order,

- (a) “apprentice” means a person who is an apprentice in the auto body technician trade;
- (b) “existing apprentice” means a person who immediately before February 1, 2009 was an apprentice in the previous apprenticeship program;
- (c) “new apprenticeship program” means an apprenticeship program under the *Auto Body Technician Trade Regulation* (AR 161/2008);
- (d) “previous apprenticeship program” means an apprenticeship program under the *Auto Body Technician Trade Regulation* (AR 117/2002);
- (e) “trade” means the occupation of auto body technician that is designated as a compulsory certification trade pursuant to the *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*;

Existing apprentices

2(1) An existing apprentice who, before February 1, 2009, was an apprentice in the previous apprenticeship program continues to be an apprentice in that program.

(2) In order to be granted a trade certificate in the trade, an existing apprentice must successfully complete the requirements of the previous apprenticeship program in the trade.

Apprentices registered on or after February 1, 2009

3 An apprentice registered on or after February 1, 2009, shall be registered in the new apprenticeship program and must successfully complete the requirements of the new apprenticeship program in the trade in order to be granted a trade certificate in the trade.

Existing trade certificates

4 A trade certificate granted in the trade before February 1, 2009 is equivalent to a trade certificate granted in the trade on or after February 1, 2009.

Coming into force

5 This Order comes into force on February 1, 2009.
