APPENDIX

Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act

INSULATOR TRADE CERTIFICATE AND CREDITS ORDER As amended by Board Order 16/2013

Interpretation

- 1 In this Order,
- (a) "apprentice" means a person who is an apprentice in the insulator trade;
- (b) "existing apprentice" means a person who immediately before August 1, 2013 was an apprentice in the previous apprenticeship program;
- (c) "new apprenticeship program" means an apprenticeship program under the trade Regulation as it exists after August 1, 2013;
- (d) "previous apprenticeship program" means an apprenticeship program under the trade Regulation as it existed before August 1, 2013;
- (e) "technical training" means technical training as defined in the *Apprenticeship Program Regulation*;
- (f) "trade" means the occupation of insulator that is designated as an optional certification trade pursuant to the *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*;
- (g) "trade Regulation" means the *Insulator Trade Regulation* (AR 284/2000).

Credit for existing 1st, 2nd and 3rd period apprentices

- **2**(1) An existing apprentice who, before August 1, 2013, has successfully completed the first or 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} periods of apprenticeship in the previous apprenticeship program is to be given credit for having successfully completed the first, 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} periods of apprenticeship, as applicable, of the new apprenticeship program.
- (2) An existing apprentice who, before August 1, 2013, has not successfully completed the first or 2nd or 3rd periods of apprenticeship is to be given credit for the technical training the apprentice has successfully completed and the hours of on the job training the apprentice has acquired in the previous apprenticeship program.
- (3) Subject to credit being granted under subsections (1) and (2), an existing apprentice must successfully complete the technical training requirements of the new apprenticeship program in the trade and the required hours of on the job training in periods 1, 2, and 3 of the previous apprenticeship program in order to be granted a trade certificate in the trade.

Existing trade certificates

3 A trade certificate granted in the trade before August 1, 2013 is equivalent to a trade certificate granted in the trade on or after August 1, 2013.

Coming into force

4 This Order comes into force on August 1, 2013.
