Interpretation

1 In this Order,

- (a) “apprentice” means a person who is an apprentice in the water well driller trade;
- (b) “existing apprentice” means a person who immediately before May 21, 2014 was an apprentice in the apprenticeship program in the water well driller trade;
- (c) “new apprenticeship program” means the apprenticeship program in the earth loop technician branch of the trade under the trade Regulation as it exists after May 21, 2014;
- (d) “technical training” means technical training as defined in the *Apprenticeship Program Regulation* (AR 258/2000);
- (e) “trade” means the occupation of water well driller that is designated as an optional certification trade pursuant to the *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*;
- (f) “trade regulation” means the *Water Well Driller Trade Regulation* (AR 94/2014).

Existing apprentices

2 An existing apprentice, subject to this Order, may continue in the apprenticeship program for the water well driller branch of the trade or enter in the new apprenticeship program.

Credit for existing apprentices

3(1) An existing apprentice who, before May 21, 2014, has successfully completed one or more periods of the apprenticeship program in the water well driller trade and enters into the new apprenticeship program is to be given credit for the first period training requirements of the new apprenticeship program.

(2) An existing apprentice who, before May 21, 2014, has not successfully completed one or more periods of the apprenticeship program in the water well driller trade and enters into the new apprenticeship program is to be given credit for the technical training and the hours of on the job training successfully completed to a maximum credit equal to the first period training requirements of the new apprenticeship program.

(3) Subject to credit being granted under subsections (1) and (2), an existing apprentice must successfully complete the requirements of the new apprenticeship program.

Credit for on the job training

4 In granting credit for hours of on the job training for the purposes of this Order, the credit granted may be a lesser amount if the Executive Director is of the opinion that the lesser amount properly reflects the actual amount of hours of on the job training that the existing apprentice had acquired in the trade before May 21, 2014.

Existing trade certificates

5 A trade certificate granted in the trade before May 21, 2014 is equivalent to a trade certificate granted in the water well driller branch of the trade on or after May 21, 2014.

Coming into force

6 This Order comes into force on June 26, 2014.
