Interpretation

1 In this Order,

- (a) “apprentice” means a person who is an apprentice in the trade;
- (b) “apprenticeship program” means apprenticeship program as defined under the *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*;
- (c) “existing apprentice” means a person who immediately before September 1, 2016 was an apprentice in the previous apprenticeship program;
- (d) “new apprenticeship program” means an apprenticeship program under the trade Regulation as it exists after September 1, 2016;
- (e) “previous apprenticeship program” means an apprenticeship program under the trade Regulation as it existed before September 1, 2016;
- (f) “technical training” means technical training as defined in the *Apprenticeship Program Regulation* (AR 258/2000);
- (g) “trade” means the occupation of locksmith that is designated as an optional certification trade pursuant to the *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*
- (h) “trade Regulation” means the *Locksmith Trade Regulation* (AR 288/2000).

Existing apprentices – requirement to enter into the new apprenticeship program

2 An existing apprentice must, subject to this Order, enter into the new apprenticeship program.

Existing apprentices – technical training requirements

- 3(1)** An existing apprentice who has completed first period technical training in the previous apprenticeship program must, subject to this Order, successfully complete first period technical training of the new apprenticeship program in order to be eligible to attend 2nd period technical training of the new apprenticeship program.
- (2)** An existing apprentice who has completed 2nd period technical training in the previous apprenticeship program must, subject to this Order, successfully complete 2nd period technical training of the new apprenticeship program in order to be eligible to attend 3rd period technical training of the new apprenticeship program.
- (3)** An existing apprentice who has completed 3rd period technical training in the previous apprenticeship

program must, subject to this Order, successfully complete 3rd period technical training of the new apprenticeship program in order to be deemed to have successfully completed 3rd period technical training of the new apprenticeship program.

- (4) An existing apprentice who has successfully completed 4th period technical training in the previous apprenticeship program shall, subject to this Order, be deemed to have successfully completed all the technical training requirements of the new apprenticeship program.

Credit for existing apprentices

- 4(1) An existing apprentice who, before September 1, 2016, has successfully completed the first, 2nd, 3rd or 4th period of apprenticeship in the previous apprenticeship program is to be given credit for the hours of on the job training the apprentice had acquired in the previous apprenticeship program, as applicable.
- (2) Subject to credit being granted under subsection (1), an existing apprentice must complete the technical training requirements of the new apprenticeship program in the trade and the required hours of on the job training in periods 1, 2, and 3 of the previous apprenticeship program in order to be granted a trade certificate in the trade.

Existing trade certificates

- 5 A trade certificate granted in the trade before September 1, 2016 is equivalent to a trade certificate granted in the trade on or after September 1, 2016.

Coming into force

- 6 This Order comes into force on September 1, 2016.
