Who Can Become an Apprentice in Alberta?

To register as an apprentice in Alberta, you must:

1) Have an eligible immigration status in Canada*, such as:

- Canadian citizen
- Permanent resident
- Convention refugee or protected person
- Refugee claimant with a valid work permit
- Post-Graduation Work Permit holders who completed an Alberta post-secondary program that is recognized as having covered all periods of classroom instruction in the applicable apprenticeship education program
- Canada–Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) Visa Holders with a Work Permit living in Canada with temporary status

2) Live or primarily work in Alberta in the scope of the trade

3) Meet the education requirements for your apprenticeship program

If you do not meet the education requirements, you may still register. You must finish the required education within one year or pass an Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT) entrance exam.
