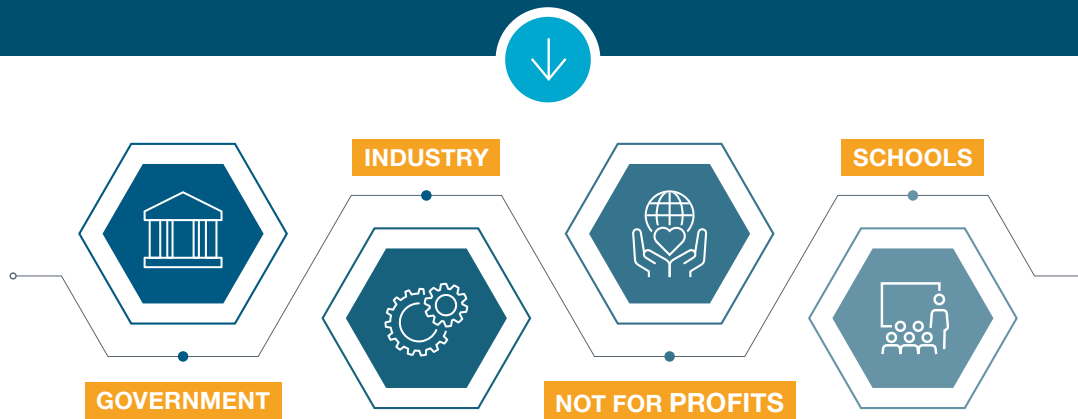


# A Team Approach to Apprenticeship and the Skilled Trades in Alberta
