What is Apprenticeship?

Alberta offers 47 Apprenticeship Education Programs, ranging in length from 1 to 4 years.

80% on-the-job

20% at a college or polytechnic institute

Earn a postsecondary credential and qualify for journeyperson certification.





Apprenticeships are a Partnership

Sponsor

- Provide on-the-job education through mentorship
- Assess apprentice progress
- Ensure apprentice gets paid

Apprentice

- Attend classes
 - Pass exams
- Learn on-the-job



Post-Secondary Institution

- Deliver classroom instruction
- Assess apprentice learning

Apprenticeship & Industry Training

 Manage and administer the apprenticeship program





Education Credentials



Education Credentials - Previously

 Under our old legislation, Alberta linked apprenticeship education and license to work in the skilled trades.



 Not recognized as an academic credential by postsecondary institutions.





Education Credentials

 Since July 2022, apprenticeship program graduates have received education credentials in addition to journeyperson certificates.

Education Credential

- Confirms post-secondary learning achievement.
- Reflects the length and complexity of the program.

Journeyperson Certificate

- Authorizes unsupervised work in the full scope of the trade anywhere in Alberta.
- Is issued when someone meets Alberta's certification standards.






Apprenticeship Credentials

Credential	Typical Duration
Certificate (Apprenticeship)	2-3 years
Diploma (Apprenticeship)	3-4 years
Advanced Diploma (Apprenticeship)	4 years



Education Credentials - Today



- Education credential
 - Certificate, Diploma or Advanced Diploma



- License to work
 - Journeyperson Certificate





Other Post-Secondary Credentials

Credential	Typical Program Duration
Certificate	1 year or less
Diploma	2 to 3 years
Post-Diploma Certificate	1 year or less
Bachelor's Degree	3 to 4 years
Graduate Certificate	1 year or less
Graduate Diploma	1 to 2 years
Master's Degree	1 to 2.5 years
Doctoral Degree	3 to 6 years



Why is this a big deal?



Prestige

 Apprenticeship programs are now on the same platform as other academic qualifications and formally recognized as post-secondary education.



Visibility

 Albertans can see how apprenticeship fits into the bigger picture of post-secondary education in Alberta and make better-informed decisions about whether to pursue it.



Education and Career Pathways

 Post-secondary institutions and employers can better understand the depth and breadth of apprenticeship education, giving the credentials value beyond a specific trade.

- Apprenticeship education is often misunderstood as an academic dead end, with few pathways to further education or career growth.
- As a result, educators, students and parents can overlook or are never introduced to apprenticeship education as an option.


